

- "Wake up Mustafa. It seems they have arrived. "




#### Part of the book

#### In search of my son...






#### Translation of 139 Stories from the Book of Gransang Bihar Al-Anwar

that book which is related to Imam Mahdi.








There is no one here, who speaks to Sayyed?




#### Part of the book
